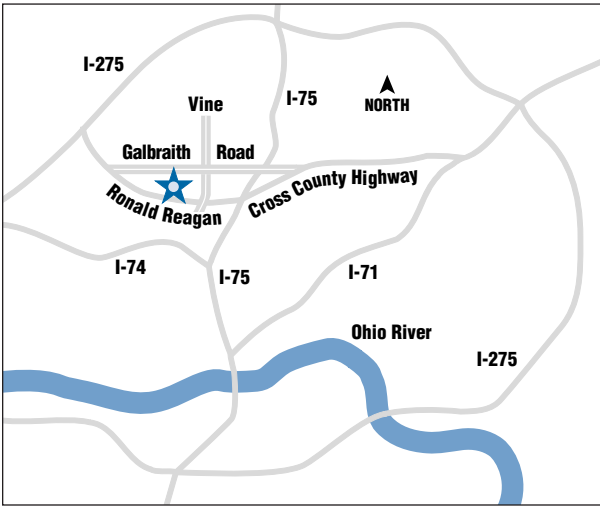


DIRECTIONS AND TRANSPORTATION



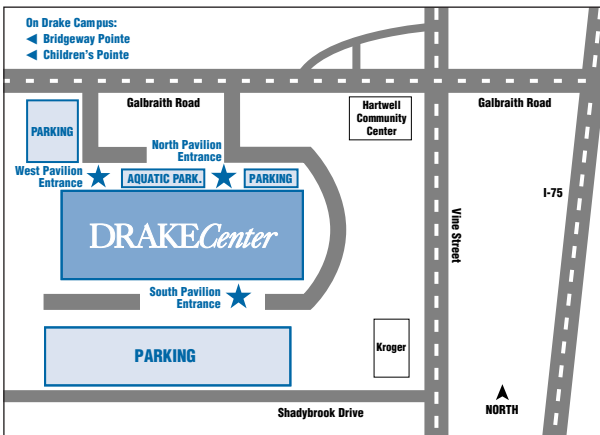
Getting to Drake Center

Drake Center is located at 151 West Galbraith Road, Cincinnati, OH 45216. It is easily accessible from all parts of the Greater Cincinnati area.

From I-75, take the Galbraith Road exit and go west one-half mile.

From Ronald Reagan Cross County Highway, take the Galbraith Road exit and go west two miles, or take the Galbraith/Winton Road exit and go east one mile.

Parking

Visitor parking. Free visitor parking is available near the front (North and West Pavilion) and rear (South Pavilion) entrances of the building. Handicapped parking spaces are available. You can enter through the main doors at these entrances; all are wheelchair-accessible.

Valet parking. For the added convenience and safety of patients and visitors, Drake also provides free valet parking at the South Pavilion entrance (7:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday [schedule subject to change]).

Aquatic and Wellness Center parking. For participants in warm-water aquatic and community wellness programs, a designated parking area is located between the North and West Pavilion entrances—in front of the Earl R. Gilreath Aquatic Therapy Center.

Inpatient/Outpatient Transportation

Inpatients. While you are an inpatient, your case manager will make arrangements for your transportation to necessary appointments at hospitals and physician offices. Depending on your insurance coverage, you may be responsible for some transportation costs.

Discharged patients. If you need special transportation after discharge due to your physical abilities, you may be eligible for the Metro Bus Access Program. Please contact your case manager if you or a family member needs information or assistance to apply.

Outpatients. If you are an outpatient at Drake, your case manager can help identify community transportation options to make your visits as easy as possible. For assistance, please contact the case manager.
