BOOK SIGNING: *OUR MOMENT OF GLORY IN THE CIVIL WAR*

On Sunday March 4th from 2:00 P.M. to 4:00 P.M., *Our Moment of Glory in the Civil War*, Revised Edition, by Chester F. Geaslen, will be introduced for the first time since its original printing in 1972! The original *Moment of Glory in the Civil War* has been expanded for a new generation of readers with the support and encouragement of the Geaslen family, with additional and updated information about the defensive fortifications and role of Northern Kentucky during the Civil War. Edited by Dr. James A. Ramage, Jeannine Kreinbrink, and Bob Clements, the revised book includes a new biographical tribute to Chester F. Geaslen; expanded data on the fortification system; a section on the famed Black Brigade of Cincinnati and their role in the construction of the fortifications; and biographies of important participants such as General Lew Wallace, Colonel Charles Whittlesey, and General Henry Heth (C.S.A). The original book by Mr. Geaslen remains intact while maps and images from the National Archives in Washington D.C. update its look!

You are invited to the publication release and book signing at the James A. Ramage Civil War Museum on Sunday March 4th from 2-4pm. The book will be on sale for \$20 and all proceeds benefit the City's James A. Ramage Civil War Museum. Contributors to the revised edition will be on hand to sign purchased books too.
